
❖ **SCLC's NSS Regular Activities 2019-20**






➤ **Blood Donation Camp – 14th August 2019**



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




➤ **College Campus Cleaning – 15th October 2019**



CCT Activities – 05/01/2020



LEGAL AID CENTRE

REPORT FOR THE EXTENSION ACTIVITIES AY 2019-20

The Legal Aid Society is built on one simple but powerful belief: that no Indian should be denied the right to equal justice. We seek to be a beacon of hope Indians who feel neglected—regardless of who they are, where they come from, or how they identify. Being an important stakeholder in the legal field, we owe a duty towards society to shoulder the responsibility of providing legal aid to the masses at large. The institutional support provided through Legal Aid Centre of the College will help the society to have access to justice through expertise without any expenses. The students on the other hand will benefit from the practical exposure and knowledge which they will gain and explore being a part of this Centre and while working on various projects and activities undertaken by the Centre. For the academic year 2019-20 total 166 students registered for the legal aid center.

The Centre conducted the following Extension activities throughout the academic year 2019-20

1. MOU with Schizophrenia Awareness Association (SAA)

Schizophrenia Awareness Association (SAA) is not for profit organization based in the city of Pune, in Maharashtra state SAA is working since from 1997 for the persons with mental illness and their families. SAA is run and managed by user survivors, family caregivers. SAA believes in their capacities and encourages them to take responsibility. As per the prior discussion in order to give official recognition to the collaboration between SAA and the Legal Aid Cell of our college executed Memorandum of Undertaking on 11/10/2019. At the same date






Students with faculty in Maha Lok Adalat- 8/2/20


The students gave information on the following topic through their skits,



Cell For Human Rights Activities (C.H.R.A)



About the Cell

Shankarrao Chavan Law College has always given importance to the concern for human rights which is deeply rooted in the Indian Constitutional system. The college has been imparting human rights education to our students to promote dignity, tolerance and peace.

Organization of "Human Rights Day" is one important activity of the college's Academic Calendar every year. Past Academic Years had witnessed Guest Lectures from eminent personalities associated with this field.

This Year the college aimed to take this venture on a larger scale by organizing "Human Rights-Week" for all the students of Law fraternity with the object of inculcating human rights values and sensitize the students about promotion of human rights.

The college also took this opportunity to inaugurate the Cell for Human Rights Activities (CHRA) on 15th December, 2012 by the hands of Senior Advocate Shri Ram Jethmalani.

The Intention behind establishing C.H.R.A is to develop social advocacy skills in students. It has been initiated as an Activity-Based Committee which shall be conducting and facilitating research and activities relating to the convergence of legal and social fields. It is an initiative of an informal group of students who are interested in promoting human rights amongst one and all.

OBJECTIVES:

- To educate and create greater awareness of Human Rights
- To study and examine cases of human rights violation in the Campus
- To train the interested group to facilitate intervention and action
- To create a network with other organizations for working in the spirit of solidarity
- To adopt a process of documentation of different cases of violation so that they can come as a reference material of some other cases in future.

WORKING OF CHRA:

Regular Activities: The cell intends to undertake to conduct in relevant contexts

- orientation programmes,
- debates,
- panel discussions,
- meaningful celebration of international Human Rights Day every year,
- Awareness programmes in schools and field visits.

Special Activities: As part of its special activities the cell plans to encompass guest lectures by academicians, advocates, activists, politicians and even officials.

Activities undertaken by the Cell:

- Organisation of Human Rights Week (10th December 2012 to 15th December 2012)
- Publication of the student-run, peer reviewed socio-legal periodical C.H.R.A Bulletin (Inaugural Issue).
- Guest Lecture by Dr. Anuradha Sahstrabudhe, founder of Dnyana Devi, an organization that works in the field of child centered community development amongst underprivileged and also runs a 24 hours Pune Child Line.
- Visit to an orphanage 'Hope House', Salisbury Park, Pune where Games and Dinner was organized for the children who stay there. Sponsor for the event - Mr Chandan Shah, Chairman of Evergreen Micronutrients, Pune.
- T-shirt painting and Poster Making on Human Rights Theme focusing on current issues such as Human Right violation, Female Foeticide, Women Empowerment, slogans against Human Right Violation etc.
- Experience Sharing Session by students who had got an opportunity to intern in various NGO's in October 2012.
- Film Screening by Advocate Rama Sarode of The Film Right to Life - a Documentary made by Sahayog Trust, Pune.
- Guest lecture by Senior Advocate Shri Ram Jethmalani on Challenges before the Criminal Justice System.
- Student Executive Members attended the Rally 'One Billion Rising' held in Pune on 14th February 2013 from Mahatma Phule Mandai to Smbhaji Park. The rally was a global initiative where around 140 countries, 10 Indian states and 13,000 global organizations participated to stop violence against women.
- Student Executive Members attended State Level One Day Basic Training Workshop on Human Rights on 2nd March 2013 at ILS, Pune; organized under the aegis of National Human Rights Commission (NHRC), New Delhi.
- Street Play on Female Foeticide at Bhore in Legal Aid Camp.

This cell was inaugurated at the auspicious hands of legal luminary **Senior Advocate Shri. Ram Jethmalani on 15th December, 2012.**




and betterment. Students and the college donated various toys and stationery items for these children.





